The reserve hosts thousands of migratory birds with internationally important numbers of ducks, geese and swans gathering in the winter to form spectacular feeding flocks on seasonally flooded wetlands. With a diversity of waterfowl, Martin Mere is a first class, year-round, wetland wildlife attraction. There is also a café and gift shop.

On **Sunday 21st March at 11.00am** there will be a tour for members with a guide and a chance for members to explore without a guide. It is hoped that members will also get together for lunch at the café.

Members will meet at Scarisbrick Hotel, Southport for an **evening meal on the Saturday**.
